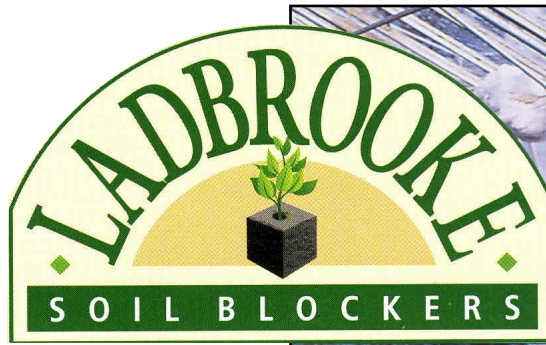
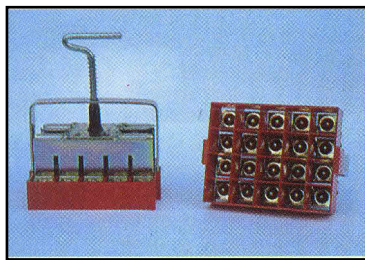


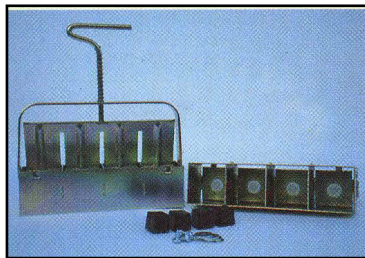
The Full Range of Soil Blockers, made by Ladbroke and sold by Blackberry Lane



The purpose of this sheet is to give an overview of the various Soil Blockers and how they may be used on their own or in conjunction with each other. Please see our other information sheet for advice on how to start producing blocks.

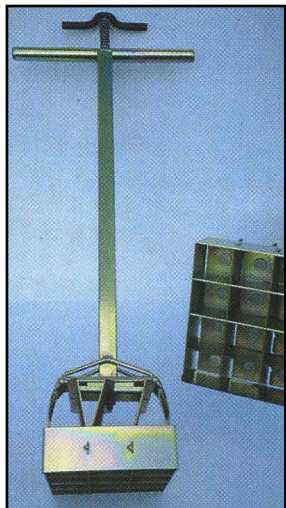


The Micro 20 produces 20 blocks, each approx. 20mm (3/4") with a small depression in the top for seed sowing. Ideal for starting small seeds, saving space, heating and watering.

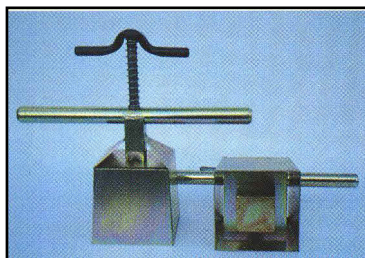


The Mini 4 produces 4 blocks, each approx. 50mm (2"), with a larger depression in the top for direct seed sowing. We supply longer 'dowel pins' which can be fitted to make larger depressions for larger seeds or small cuttings.

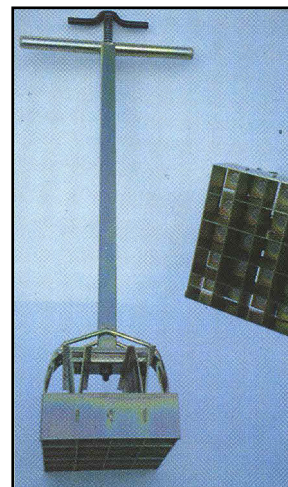
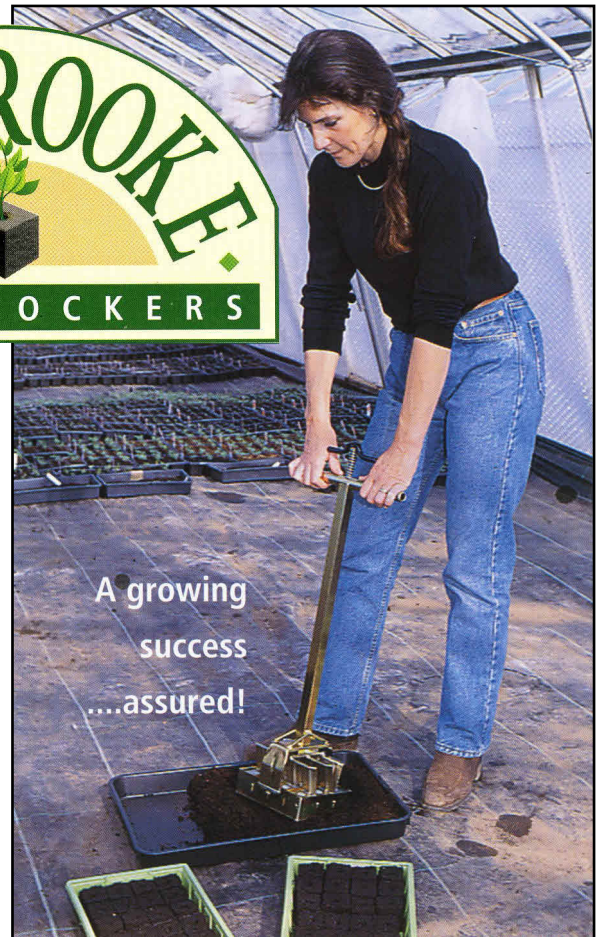
Cube Inserts are also available for the Mini 4, making cubic spaces in the top of the blocks, ready to receive small seedlings started in Micro 20 blocks.



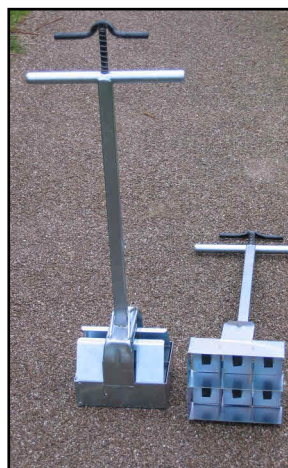
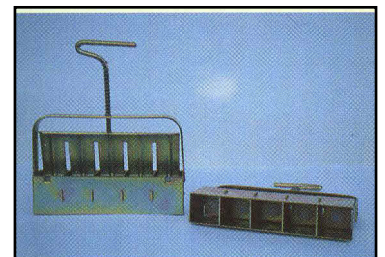
The Multi 12 makes 12 blocks the same size as those produced in the Mini 4. It is designed for larger-scale production of soil blocks. 'Dowel pins' are supplied as with the Mini 4 or Cube Inserts may be fitted to enable Micro 20 blocks to be 'potted on'.



The Maxi 1 produces a single 100mm (4") block with a 50mm Cube Insert to receive soil blocks from the Mini 4 or Multi 12. Useful when additional protected growing time is needed.



The Mini 5 produces 5 x 38mm (1 1/2") blocks with small depressions in the top, ideal for starting individual seeds. The Multi 20 makes 20 of the same size blocks, for larger-scale production. Using Cube Inserts in these blocks is not recommended, as the tops of the block walls would be very thin and fragile, but 'dowel pins' (supplied) are fine.



The Multi 6 makes 6 blocks, each 63mm (2 1/2") x 63mm (2 1/2") x 75mm (3") and with 20mm Cube Inserts to receive Micro 20 blocks.
